OPERA HEROINE was rated in third position for the opening mile, moved into second before the sixth fence, took the lead prior to the seventh fence, edged clear from the field, cruised into the stretch while relatively in hand, cleared the final fence well and proved much the best under right hand urging. WELL FASHIONED settled near the middle of the field, was roused after clearing the eighth fence, moved to the outside, chased the winner on the final turn, continued the pursuit in the stretch and was second best. LONESOME NUN settled towards the rear of the field, moved closer on the final turn, was asked in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while well clear for the show. UPPER GULCH raced on the outside, was asked on the final turn, chased in upper stretch, stumbled at the final fence and weakened. RED DIRT GIRL followed the clear leader from second, moved closer on the second turn, gave up second position prior to the sixth fence, was through on the final turn and faded. DEPUTY EMPRESS went sideways at the start, was very slow to begin, spotted the field at least five lengths, lagged at the rear and showed little. MAYA CHARLI quickly moved clear of the field, pulled in the early going, hesitated before clearing the second fence, raced along with a clear advantage, lost the lead prior to the seventh fence and stopped. BEATING THE ODDS fell at the third fence and unseated the rider then was walked off. FARAH T SALUTE completely refused at the start despite strong encouragement from the rider. Following a stewards' inquiry into the start, no change was made.
